On the above date and time, I responded to the above listed incident to cover Deputy Popp on an active domestic. Orange Central communications advised that an assault had occurred and that the male subject had left the scene a grey GMC SUV. Deputy Popp spotted a vehicle matching that description leaving the area and turned around to investigate. The vehicle in question had and inspection violation and Deputy Popp conducted a traffic stop on I-85 north bound while I responded to the incident location.

Upon arrival I was greeted by daughter of the victim, Maria Fabiola Huerta-Mata. acted as translator for much of our interaction, as English was not Maria's first language. Maria, who was visibly pregnant, told me that she had been out with her child's father, Jocsan Cornejo-Cornejo. When they returned home they became involved in an argument about Jocsan's excessive drinking. The argument escalated and Maria said that Jocsan grabbed her underneath her chin and punched her in her stomach. Maria then pushed Jocsan off in self-defense. She then said that Jocsan attempted to leave with the children and grabbed his daughter, by the hair and attempted to leave with her. managed to get away and Jocsan then left in a grey GMC SUV.

While speaking with Maria and Deputy Popp made contact with me and confirmed the individual he stopped was indeed the suspect that had left the scene and he suspected that he was intoxicated.

After clearing the scene, I responded to Deputy Popp's traffic stop where he informed me that he was placing Jocsan under arrest for DWI. I accompanied Deputy Popp to the Hillsborough Police Department where he performed intox procedures, while I wrote warrants for Assault on a female, Assault on a child under 12, and battery of an unborn child. I then responded to the Orange Country Magistrate's Office and presented my testimony to Magistrate Jordan who affirmed the above listed charges. Deputy Popp then presented Mr. Cornejo before Magistrate Jordan for his driving while impaired charges; thereafter the above warrants were served on Mr. Cornejo and he was remanded to the custody of the Orange County Jail Under no bond.

It should be noted that CPS was notified and the on call CPS worker, contacted me by phone. Once I told her that the suspect was in custody, she advised that the children were no longer in immediate danger and she would call me back at a more convenient time.

Video of this incident was captured on my body worn camera and was uploaded to the Sheriff's Office BWC video files.

On June 23 2019 I was dispatched the above area in reference to a domestic. Dispatch said the male party left in a gray in color GMC SUV and was intoxicated.

I arrived in the area within a few minutes and noticed a Gray in color GMC Arcadia leaving the area. The SUV got on I-85 South Bound traveling at 70mph. The vehicle then speed up to 75 Mph and then 80 mph. I ran the tag though communication and it was not clear at that time if this was in-fact the vehicle from the domestic, but it had an inspection violation. I conducted a traffic stop near Mile marker #169. The vehicle came to a stop and the driver exited the vehicle.

I told the male to get back in the vehicle and he complied. I approached the passenger side of the vehicle and the driver, a Hispanic male, said he knew why I pulled him over, and said it was because there was an issue with his girlfriend.

I asked the male to exit the vehicle because we could not converse over the sound of traffic.

I asked the male what was going on. The male said he was "a little drunk" and his girlfriend had been at a friend's house drinking. The male said his girlfriend wanted to go home, so she drove them back home. The driver said his girlfriend became upset with him telling him that he smelled. The male said his girlfriend got up in his face and he pushed her back. The male said his girlfriend then slapped him in the face and he left the residence. I made contact with Cpl. Davis who was on scene speaking with the caller. Cpl. Davis said he would be seeking domestic assault charges.

The male said he was "a little drunk" because he had 6 or 7 shots of Tequila and had been drinking beer. The male said he started drinking around 4:00pm. Lt. Jones was on scene and assisted me with the Driving While impaired investigation. I turned the forward facing blue lights off and Lt. Jones conducted the walk and turn and one leg stand test on the paved shoulder of the road. Lt. Jones advised the male showed signs of impairment on both tests. I noticed the male had red glassy eyes, and was unsteady on his feet while conducting the standardized field sobriety tests. I noticed the mild smell of alcohol coming from his person while he was standing in the opened air, and it became a very strong odor when he was sitting inside the patrol car.

The male submitted to two preliminary breath tests one at 1:24 am and one at 1:30am. Both indicated a positive result.

At this point I formed the opinion due to my training and experience that the male had been driving a motor vehicle on a public highway and that his physical and mental faculties were appreciably impaired. I placed the driver under arrest for Driving while impaired and transported him to the Hillsborough Police Department. I am a Chemical Analyst though the NC Department of Health and Human Services with the Intoximeter, Intox EC/IR II Permit # 28680E. The male provided two consecutive breath samples which yielded a result of 0.12. The male was
